Theresa* came in to HAAM earlier this week. A HAAM client, Theresa initially came in with a list of medical supplies that were ruined in the storm, which she needed help replacing. HAAM helped with those medical supplies as well as her utilities and rent and a food order. In addition, Theresa received cleaning supplies for flood remediation. During her interactions with the case worker it was revealed that Theresa also recently adopted 4 grandchildren who attend school in the Humble ISD school system who lost their school supplies along with other things in the flood. Theresa noted that the kids had been different since the storm, less interested in going to school and socializing with friends as a result of the stress inflicted by the hurricane. HAAM provided them with clothes, new backpacks full of supplies, and other forms of support. The case worker has already followed up with Theresa and she reports that the kids were so grateful for the new supplies! HAAM will continue to work with Theresa and her family.
